

2024 Broad Water Innovations College Scholarship Guidelines and Application Deadline: June 15, 2024

Purpose: To promote the education of Virginia citizens in fields related to natural resource conservation and environmental protection.

Qualifications: One education scholarship will be awarded annually by Broad Water Innovations.

<u>Individual applicants must be full-time students enrolled in—or who have been accepted into—a college-level curriculum in natural resource conservation and/or environmental studies.</u> Qualified applicants shall document a Grade Point Average (GPA) of 3.0 or greater, or appropriate equivalent of individual scholastic achievement.

Applicants shall demonstrate an active interest in natural resource conservation and/or environmental studies. The applicant's most recent official high school or college transcript must accompany the application.

One applicant will be chosen for this scholarship. Eligible applicants are high school seniors or enrolled undergraduate college students who are residents of Virginia. It is the responsibility of Broad Water Innovations to screen applications for eligibility in accordance with the criteria stated herein. **Applications not fulfilling minimum criteria shall not be considered.**

Amount Awarded: One \$2,500.00 scholarship is offered annually.

A check will be issued by Broad Water Innovations to the selected school on behalf of each scholarship recipient.
